Situated right in the heart of the Abukuma mountain range, Tamura is a heart-warming city, blessed with rich natural beauty and a deep tradition of history and culture. In the city there are two limestone caves that are particularly popular with tourists. One of these is the Irimizu Limestone Cave, which has been designated a national natural monument. The other is the Abukuma Cave, and both are visited by many tourists each year. In 2019, the Ban-Etsu Expressway "Tamura Central Smart IC" was established, at a location about ten minutes by car from Tamura City

Industrial Park. It is expected that this will improve the convenience of Tamura and generate new traffic flows.

It was now 13 years since Tamura began its new journey as a city. I believe that each and every citizen should share in the current reality and future vision of the city, and that we should go forward together, hand in hand, towards the future.

I will work to implement necessary reforms quickly, listening to the direct comments of the citizens, so that all will feel happy to have been born in Tamura, and happy to live here.
