This is the god of warding off evil spirits which is said to have been built to ward off an epidemic of bad diseases that spread during the Edo era. Each doll is characterized by holding a naginata (halberd) and a sword, with its arms outstretched in a blocking gesture. Even today, each one is enshrined at three locations in Funehiki, each with different facial expressions, so you can compare them and receive the blessings they offer!

(Takine-machi)

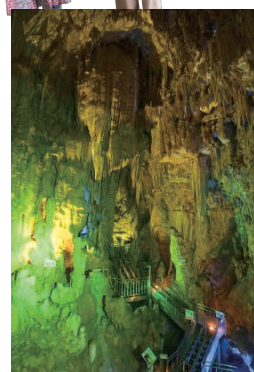
This is called Abukuma-do Limestone Cave which is a world of fantastic beauty created over a long period of time in a cave with an open area of 600m. The unique beauty of the stalactites, which are so many in number and variety, is breathtaking. There are many attractions such as "the Takine Goten palace," the largest space in the cave, and "the Moon World," the first limestone cave in Japan to have a dimming system for stage production!

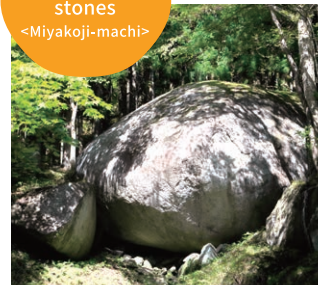

Named for its tortoise shape, this megalith is 10.7 m high, 50.5 m in circumference, and weighs 2,800 tons. The stone has been worshipped to pray for good health and good fortune in accordance with the saying, "A crane lives for a thousand years, a tortoise lives for ten thousand years." Legend has it that there are footprints on the top of the stone where a tengu, a long-nosed goblin, descended from.

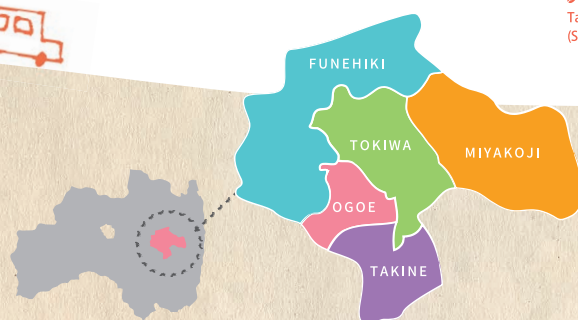

The taste of cheese cut in the shape of a stag beetle also goes so well with the tomato sauce.

In mid-May, when the azaleas are in full bloom, the entire summit of the mountain is covered with bright red flowers, creating a spectacular view. Visitors can also enjoy easy hiking from the spring azalea season through the season of autumn leaves.

Blessed with abundant nature, Takine is an excellent spot for astronomical observation because it is difficult for city lights to reach the area even at night. The Hoshino Mura "Star Village" Astronomical Observatory is equipped with a 65cm reflective telescope, the largest in Fukushima, and a planetarium where even children can experience the mysteries of the universe in an easy-to-understand way.
