This is a mysterious shrine which unexpectedly appears in the rich in nature. The shrine is built in a rare architectural style called kake-zukuri, in which the three corners of the foundation are built on a natural boulder, and is nestled against a cliff. You need to walk eneath the building and climb up to the front of the shrine, then you will have the excellent view. This is a recommended spot where you can enjoy both a feeling of seclusion and a location thought to be imbued with mystical energy at the same time!

• 232 Aza-katono, Wasegawa

Named for its tortoise shape, this megalit is 10.7 m high, 50.5 m in circumference, and weighs 2,800 tons. The stone has been worshipped to pray for good health and good fortune in accordance with the saying, "A crane lives for a thousand years, a tortoise lives for ten thousand years." Legend has it that there are footprints on the top of the stone where a tengu, a long-nosed goblin, descended from.

In mid-May, when the azaleas are in full bloom, the entire summit of the mountain is covered with bright red flowers, creating a spectacular view. Visitors can also enjoy easy hiking from the spring azalea season through the season of autumn leaves.

Blessed with abundant nature, Takine is an excellent spot for astronomical observation because it is difficult for city lights to reach the area even at night. The Hoshino Mura "Star Village" Astronomical Observatory is equipped with a 65cm reflective telescope, the largest in Fukushima, and a planetarium where even children can experience the mysteries of the universe in an easy-to-understand way.
